



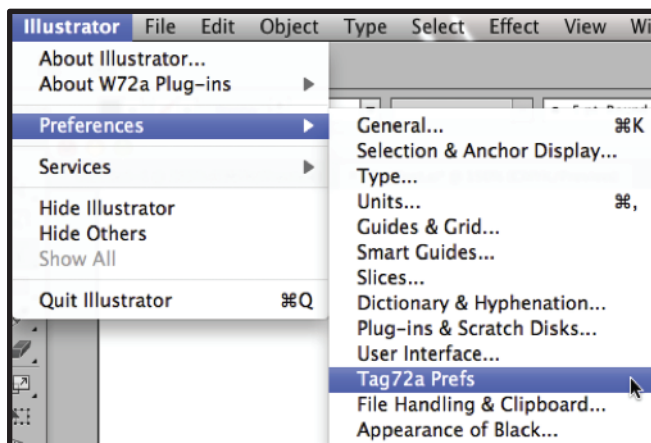
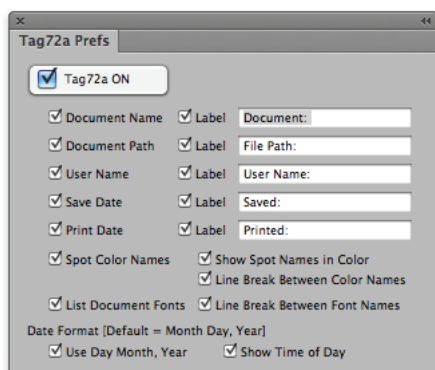
Tag72a for CS6 & CC

Installation

Copy the file named "Tag72a.aip" into your Illustrator Plug-ins folder and re-launch Illustrator.

What's New?

Tag72a for CS6 & CC adds the options to list spot colors and fonts used in the document.



Activation

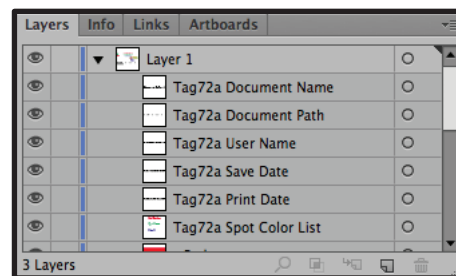
After installing, select the Illustrator->Preferences->Tag72a Prefs menu to display the preferences panel. It is a floating panel and can be left open, minimized or closed. Turn on Tag72a and select the desired options by checking the appropriate checkboxes.

What it does

The first time Tag72a is run, a line of text for each selected option will be added on the top layer. This text can then be repositioned and/or formatted.

Each time a document is saved or printed, the selected options will be updated. Multiple copies of the tag text can be created.

Existing text can be made to update by renaming it in the layers panel using the exact names shown above (e.g. renaming an existing point or area text object "Tag72a Print Date" will cause it to update with the print date).



Please Note - Spot Colors in Placed & Raster Images

Tag72a will recognize spot colors used in placed EPS and DCS files but **not** TIFF, PDF, PhotoShop Native or embedded rasters. If you have spot colors that are used only in images of those types and want Tag72a to include them in the spot color list, you will need to create a small object of that color somewhere (off the artboard is okay).
